

THIS INDENTURE Made this Twenty Second day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety **BETWEEN** James F. M^o. Krown State A. M^o. Krown his wife Della W. M^o. - Krown & Anna J. M^o. Krown of the City & County of Albany & State of New York parties of the first part and Thomas Helme M. D. of the town of Kinderland County & State aforesaid party of the second part **WITNESSETH** that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars to us duly paid have sold and by these presents do give and convey to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns **All** that certain lot piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the town of Kinderland County & State aforesaid bounded and described as follows viz Beginning at a point at the southern edge of the plank track near the center of the Great Western Turnpike where it is intersected by the westerly line of a highway leading past the dwelling of M^o. H. Krown which said point bears North six degrees & thirty minutes west two chains forty one links from the most northerly corner of the dwelling house of M^o. M^o. Krown & runs from thence along the westerly side of said road leading past M^o. M^o. Krown dwelling house & runs from thence along the westerly side of said road leading past M^o. M^o.
