Y., party of the second part, WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and fifty dollars to us duly paid have sold and by these presents does grant and convey to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, ALL that certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the town of Guilderland County of Albany Bounded and described

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and culture by old country road of soft soil the tree standing on the line of James Pitemari  
etc on the south of the forest path running along Pittsfield line north twenty one rods  
from the Pittsfield highway running the south line boundary of said highway exactly on  
said path and about thirty feet from a tree parallel with the line of the aforesaid
