eration of the sum of Twenty five
hundred dollars to be duly paid
have sold and by these presents do
grant and convey to the said parties
of the second part their heirs and assigns.

ALL that certain piece or parcel of
land situate at the Commercial in
the town of Guilderland Albany
County bounded & described as
follows Commencing at a point
in the centre of the Western Bank
Road being the southwest corner of
a lot owned by Mr. Shear now in
Clarke and Remond a northward
course along the west line of the
Shear road Clark Lot. five chain
