Unfortunately I will not be able to attend the meeting on the 24th. But I do have a couple of suggestions. First, we use a single name for the event that is going to occure on Sept 20th. We should use the name, that I believe, was agreed on by the committee that met last night, "McKownville Sidewalk Celebration".

Secondly, it is my strong recomendation that only a report be given to the Board concerning the Sidewalk Celebration, no real discussion is necessary. I believe it best if Ellen and I fashion a report and deliver it to the Board to keep them informed. An additional area of interest is what we know about the "Sheep in the Meadow" plan. By next Tuesday Ellen should have a bit more info that I am sure the board will be interested in.
