The Association is offering the following bare root trees for Fall planting:

Japanese Tree Lilac, grows to 20' high and wide, white flowers in early summer \$76.00

Serviceberry, small native tree, 20' tall and 15' wide, white flowers in early spring \$85.00

Ornamental Pear, white flowers in early spring, grows to 40' and about 1/3 as wide \$76.00

Skyline Honeylocust, 45' in height and 35' in spread, adapts well to hot, dry sites \$74.00

Ginkgo, grows to 60' high and 40' wide, lovely fan shaped leaves turn yellow in fall \$97.00

Greenspire Linden, 50' high and 30' wide, lovely pyramidal form and yellow fall color \$72.00
