This refers to copy of your letter of July 18, 1967 to Deputy Assistant Postmaster General Edward V. Dorsey, concerning postal service at McKnownville, New York.

Inquiry by this office indicates that this area is served from the Pine Station, 12203 of the Albany New York post office, by one full residential foot route and small parts of the three residential mounted routes plus part of a Rural Delivery route. Close to ninety percent of the deliveries by the city routes are made to the door.

There are approximately 750 residential deliveries and 75 business deliveries in this area. The population is estimated to be between 2500 and 3000 persons. About 60 of the business deliveries are located in the Stuyvesant Plaza-Executive Park Shopping Central and office building development. The distance from the Pine Station to this area is $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 2 miles. There are 5 mail collection points in the area.

We are authorizing the Postmaster, Albany, New York to advertise for a contract station. If established, this contract station we provide financial service to patrons.
