RESOLVED that pursuant to Local Law No. 2 of 1967 the parking of motor vehicles in the areas hereinafter designated is hereby prohibited and the supervisor is hereby directed to cause appropriate signs indicating such prohibition to be erected:

Along those portions of the easterly and westerly sides of all Town streets and highways lying easterly of Fuller Road and running northerly from Western Turnpike for a distance of 30 feet from the intersection of Route 20.

and it is hereby further

RESOLVED that this resolution shall be deemed supplementary to and shall not rescind any previous resolution made by this Town Board heretofore issued or made affecting parking along any of the streets or highways affected by this resolution, and it is hereby further

RESOLVED that employees of the Town Highway Department and Town police officers are hereby authorized to issue notices of violations hereof and serve the same upon such violators by placing such notices on the windshields of motor vehicles in violation. Such notices shall state that a charge of violation may be disposed of by a voluntary payment to the Town Clerk of \$2.00 and that upon failure of the person so served to respond to such notice within ten (10) days of its date an action for maximum civil penalties as prescribed by law may be commenced by the Town of Guilderland or such violator may be otherwise prosecuted as provided by law.
