Dear Mr. Walters:


We have received many complaints from the residents of the McKownville area relative to the conditions of the streets after the completion of the sewer work. These complaints refer to 'pot holes', 'wash boards', ponding of water, tar adhesion to foot wear, improper restoration of lawns, and clean-up of streets and debris. In summary, there is considerable dissatisfaction by the residents with the completed work.

Since we do not have the benefit of the contractual documents, we must assume that either the contract was not met, or that the contractor has not completed the work. In either case, it would seem good practice would have called for finished or restored work to at least equal the original conditions. This is not the case.

Is it possible that the described conditions are temporary?

We would appreciate your letting us know of the Town's plans to remedy these unsatisfactory conditions.
