As you are probably aware, last November the dam that created the impoundment known locally as Harrington's Pond (NYS-DEC-Water Index No. H-221-4-3-P-257) was breached and failed. The loss of the dam drained the impoundment which contained approximately 75% of the storage volume available as a water supply for the McKownville--Birchmont Water District (Guilderland Township, Albany County).
