Attached are copies of election law concerning petitions and voting.

Petitions must be filed 30 days from date of adoption of resolution (March 8 - April 7).

Persons over 18 yrs. of age may solicit signatures.

"The petition may be made upon separate sheets and the signatures to each sheet shall be authenticated in the manner provided by the election law for the authentication of designating petitions. The several sheets so signed and authenticated when fastened together and offered for filing shall be deemed to constitute one petition." (Article 7, Section 91, Town Law)

Signatures should be legal signatures.

Qualified people in McKownville or Westmere Water Districts may sign petitions.

I asked Mr. Tabner if a petition could be invalidated because of one signature. He said: "Barring fraud, no".

The Town pays expenses for special elections.
