Dear Mr. Wiebe:

The McKownville Improvement Association is opposed to the granting of the variance to the zoning registations and to the issuance of the special use permit requested by Salvatore J. Fiata for the property at 1246 Western Avenue.

In November 1972 and in January 1973 the McKownville Improvement Association opposed the granting of a spcial use permit for piptaza restaurant and then for a fired chicken restaurant at this same address.

The arguments cited then are not now irrelevant: the odors and garbage and nuisance to the neighbors and the area, the increased hazards from cars turning leftwardsontofor from Western Avenue, the already inadequate parking in the area of the Across-the-Street Pub and the congestion caused by the customers of that Pub, and the increased congestion caused by customers of the new restaurant to the McKownville Firehouse, which would be its neighbor. The property is not a good sate for the proposed use.

I hope that I can count on your opposition to the granting of the requested varaance and special use permit.
