Super. Walters opened the hearing with the statement the Town intended to restrict Recreation spending to Tawasentha Park, including several \$50,000 improvements and acquiring more land there.

One McKownville resident protested so-called bus service to Tawasentha and a Youth Commission member stated additional bus service was planned in 1979. A request for more help in the Ice Skating program on McKownville Reservoir was kicked around - Super. Walters will do nothing officially as he won't pay higher Liability Insurance premiums. Walters said McKown Grove purchase application to U. S. Govt still pending, but he intended to keep the acreage idle, on account of cost.

I repeated your proposal for a Town Park near McKownville, justified by our compact area and numerous children. Also pointed out that Town should maintain path, and permit access, on the Water Line right-of-way that extends from Waverly west to Fuller Road. Note it passes north of 24 Parkwood St. Mrs. Barry keeps it open there. At Norwood, just south of Butlers. Many kids could use same on their way to Stuyvesant. Mr. Walters said the Town had no maps of same - said his people didn't know where the Water Line is
